A voice companion that calls adults with autism or IDD and aging parents on any phone, including landlines. It keeps families informed through concise recaps and safety alerts, always identifies itself as AI, and follows a published safety and crisis protocol.

Five-level distress detection • Simultaneous alerts to approved emergency contacts • Live transfer chain • Stranger screening • Never says “I love you”

Technology

Neuromem provides durable, caregiver-controlled memory. Voice Insight tracks speech and cognitive baselines against the person’s own past and is not a diagnosis. The unified companion system is patent pending.
